

1. What key issue does your company tackle, and what impact will it have on the world?

With our bionic bioreactor approach, we overcome the decade long problem of scaling all kinds of sensitive cell cultures into industrial scale.

This particularly holds for innovative immune and stem cells.

In doing so, we will make these life-saving cell therapies available for everyone!





2. What special skills or innovations make your company stand out?

We are rethinking bioreactor design completely.



As a result, we developed a set of IP, like our proprietary Membrane Stirrer and our in-situ perfusion bottom for our single-use bioreactors, which are unique in the field.

In fact, our Membrane Stirrer, for instance, is the industry's only system achieving sufficient gas transfer without using bubbles.



3. What inspired you to found this company?

To make our technologies available for every lab, thereby providing a helpful toolbox for cell cultivation to researchers all over the globe.

A lot of them are working on the next cure for cancers, Diabetes, Parkinson etc. But they are facing scale-up problems, related to bubble-aeration and – therewith – cell-loss.
